Critical Infrastructure (CI) Consultation – Data Sector

Co design on the draft rules for the Data Sector began on June 29. For those providing data storage or processing services to designated CI assets (which in superannuation is likely to be registrable superannuation entity licensees that hold total assets over \$20 billion) you will be captured in these new requirements.
